Sankaranarayanan, the Honourable minister for Finance of our state is not a de jure Minister but only a member of the Legislative Assembly as he has not been sworn in in accordance with Article 164(3) of the Constitution of India and hence for the presentation of the Annual Financial Statement of this state for the year 2002-2003 by virtue of Article 202 of the constitution as he is legally incompetent. It is also our firm and categorical belief that no person owing true allegiance to the constitution of India and having faith in the rule of law will accept this unconstitutional act.
